



DALEA PULCHRA INDIGO BUSH

This evergreen shrub is an Arizona native. It has an open, rounded form with delicate silver foliage. Masses of purple flowers are produced in the winter and early spring. The nectar-rich blossoms attract lots of bees and butterflies. Indigo bush thrives in full sun and reflected heat exposures. It also tolerates temperatures as low as 15° F. Indigo bush is short-lived if over-watered, so plant it in well-drained soil and be careful not to kill it with kindness.
