



## EREMOPHILA X SUMMERTIME BLUE™

This particular selection came to us from Down Under about a decade ago, and has been a stellar performer in our trial garden. This large, spreading evergreen shrub grows to about 6 feet tall by 10 feet wide. The narrow light green leaves occur on arching branches, giving the shrub a fountain-like appearance. Summertime Blue™ is sprinkled with tubular lilac-blue flowers from spring till the end of summer. Having originated from heavy soils in its native land, this plant is well adapted to the clay soils of the Southwest. Summertime Blue™ is very drought-tolerant, and handles full sun and reflected heat like a champ. Hardy to frost and extended dry periods, this gem will be a great addition to the line-up of emu bushes. Hardy to 15°F. USDA Zone 8.
