



## MUHLENBERGIA LINDHEIMERI AUTUMN GLOW®

This Texas native grass has a long and successful history as a durable landscape staple. The narrow, light green leaves form a dense mound to 5 feet tall by 4 feet wide. During the fall months, its tall spikes of light yellow flowers glow when backlit by the sun. Autumn Glow® is very adaptable, tolerating full sun to almost full shade, and most soil types. It is a good choice for retention basins or other areas that receive periodic flooding. It makes a great backdrop for *Muhlenbergia capillaris* Regal Mist®. It will turn dormant in most regions in the winter months, and requires a heavy pruning in the early spring to remove brown foliage.
