



OPUNTIA TURPINII PINE CONE PRICKLY PEAR

The unique pads of this cactus are thick, green to brown cylindrical joints that look much like pine cones. The length varies to about 4 inches. This spineless selection may harbor a few glochids. In the summer pale pink 2 inch diameter flowers are produced at the tips of the joints. Place in part shade and provide excellent drainage. This is an excellent cactus for rock gardens and clay containers. Hardy to 15° F it is placed in USDA Zone 8.
