

## WEDELIA (ZEXMENIA) HISPIDA DEVIL'S RIVER<sup>TM</sup>

Devil's River<sup>TM</sup> tops out at 3 feet tall and wide, making it ideal for use in smaller spaces such as parking lots and medians. Throughout the late spring, summer, and early fall the dark green foliage is sprinkled with bright orangeyellow daisy-like flowers. In the winter months this shrub can look scruffy, so an early spring pruning is recommended to remove any frost-damaged foliage. Devil's River<sup>TM</sup> can be planted in full sun to part shade. In shadier locations the growth habit is more lanky and spreading, but is still very appealing. Once established, this plant may reseed where soils are moist.
