



Penstemon barbatus 'Coral Baby' Coral Baby Penstemon

Coral Baby Penstemon comes to us from the Colorado Plant Select® program, this plant was found by renowned plantsman Kelly Grummons. This penstemon blooms throughout the warm season, in the lower deserts there is a spring and fall show, while the higher deserts can expect color all through the summer. Coral-red tubular flowers are produced on 2 to 3 foot flower stalks that hummingbirds find irresistible. The plant has narrow green leaves to 5 inches long. This plant is hardy to -30° F, and prefers middle to higher elevations. Partial shade is best to grow in lower deserts. As with all penstemons, this plant demands good drainage and will rot out if overwatered.
