



Baccharis hybrid 'Starn' Thompson® P.P.#11240

Similar in growth habit to *Baccharis* hybrid 'Centennial', this patented clone can be used in mass plantings to cover large areas on golf courses, streetscapes, or other commercial projects. This spreading shrub stays green all year, and tolerates extreme heat and reflected heat. This clone is a male plant, which means that it does not produce the messy white fluff (seed head litter) produced in abundance by the female 'Centennial'. As a male plant, Thompson™ also eliminates the production of unwanted seedlings that often grow up through stands of 'Centennial'. If possible, avoid planting or pruning this plant in the hot summer months. Once plants are established, cut back the irrigation by 30% to maintain a more compact size. Thompson® is easily identified by the patent tag.
