



Agave victoria-reginae 'Compacta' Compact Queen Victoria Agave

This is a more compact version of an already petite agave. It is an excellent choice for small planting areas or containers. Its short, stout leaves are deep green with prominent white markings, and form a tight rosette to 12 inches across. Compact Queen Victoria agave is very slow growing and long-lived, taking many years to reach flowering size. As with most agaves the mother plant will expire after flowering but it will often produce numerous offsets. Plant it in full sun and water sparingly to maintain the tightest form.
