



## Baileya multiradiata Desert Marigold

This tough little perennial produces large, bright yellow daisy-like flowers in the spring, summer and fall. The blossoms are carried far above the silver-grey foliage on slender stems. Topping out at 12 inches tall and wide, Desert Marigold is ideal for tucking into tight planting spaces. Plant it in full sun, and a well-drained soil. Desert marigold will rot out easily if over-watered. Often used in combination with other native perennials, it is also spectacular in a mass planting. It reseeds readily.
