



## Buddleja marrubifolia Woolly Butterfly Bush

The soft, silver foliage of woolly butterfly bush helps to liven up winter landscapes. Combine this rounded evergreen shrub with green-leaved plants for an interesting contrast. Woolly butterfly bush grows to 5 feet tall and wide, maintaining a dense form with little maintenance. As an added bonus orange, marble-sized flowers are produced nearly year-round with the heaviest flowering in spring and summer. This remarkable landscape plant is a magnet for butterflies! Woolly butterfly bush is native from southwest Texas into New Mexico, in canyons, arroyos and on slopes at elevations from 1800 to 3800 feet. It is very tolerant of heat, intense sun and drought. It prefers full sun and well-drained soils. Hardy to 10°F.
