



## Muhlenbergia reverchonii Undaunted® Seep Muhly

At first glance this grass resembles its sister *Muhlenbergia capillaris* (Gulf Muhly). While not quite as flashy, this grass has some subtle strengths of her own. Undaunted® Seep Muhly is smaller, often topping out at 2 feet tall. It blooms earlier in the fall with softer pink flowers and is considerably more cold hardy than *Muhlenbergia capillaris*. Seep Muhly is very resilient; handling dry, rocky limestone soils and moist clay soils equally well. It is extremely resistant to browsing by deer and other animals. Older plants form a curly thatch of foliage resembling a soft cushion. This is a wonderful grass to incorporate into meadows or to plant around water features and seeps.

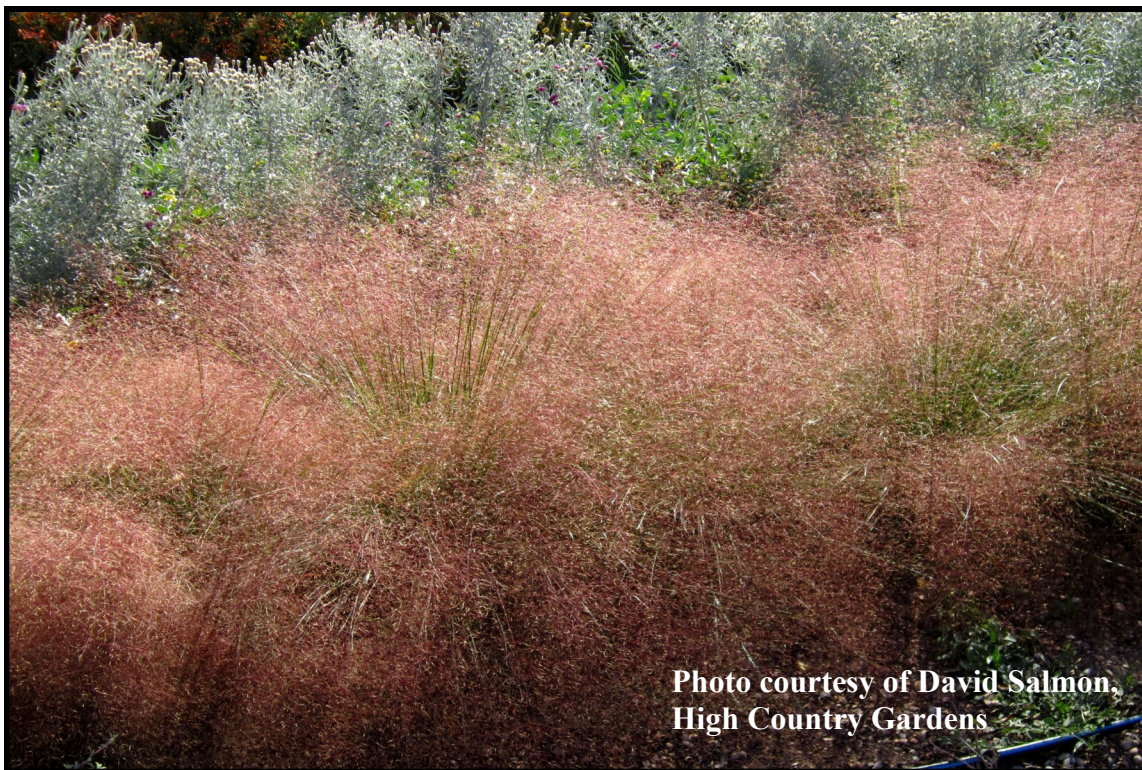
