



Pedilanthus bracteatus Tall Slipper Plant

Pedilanthus bracteatus is a great succulent that can thrive in a variety of exposures. This is a thicker, more substantial cousin of *P. macrocarpus*, and also tolerates full sun and frost much better. Plants can handle temperatures down to 20°F, but will take tip damage starting at about 25°F. Tall Slipper Plant will stay in leaf through the warm season, although they will produce more leaves in the shade. This is also a great bloomer. You can expect to have the red-orange flower bracts grace your plants from early summer through the fall. Great choice for containers or in the ground.
