

Quercus polymorpha Monterrey Oak

West Texas and Mexico are the native ranges for this semi-evergreen tree. Its narrow, upright form in youth eventually develops into a rounded crown to 60 feet in diameter. The irregularly lobed leaves emerge with a reddish-maroon color and gradually turn a deep blue-green. Monterrey Oak does well at low and middle desert elevations, and is generally evergreen in the Phoenix area. Plant in full sun and well-drained soils. Hardy to 0° F, USDA Zone 7.
