



## Rhus trilobata 'Autumn Amber' Prostrate Sumac

This prostrate form of Three Leaf Sumac has a trailing habit with a height ranging from 6 inches to 2 feet over time. Spreading to 5-6 feet, this extremely cold hardy plant covers a lot of ground and is useful for erosion control. The fall foliage is spectacular, displaying various shades of orange and red. Clusters of yellow flowers emerge in the spring before the plant leafs out, and red-orange berries follow in the summer. Experts have indicated this plant is synonymous with *Rhus aromatica*.
