



Zephyranthes X 'Prairie Sunset' Coral Rain Lily

This genus is native to Central and South America, and produces clumps of little bulbs with glossy, dark green grass-like leaves. 'Prairie Sunset' is a hybrid between *Zephyranthes* x 'Capricorn' and *Z. candida*. It has a more evergreen quality during the hot summer months than other species of rain lily. Periods of high humidity throughout the summer and fall will produce slender stalks with lovely crocus-like flowers that fade from apricot to peach.
